



Livestock Checkers Course

The livestock checkers course provides a basic introduction to stock checking in the conservation/land-based sector. The course is ideal for beginners, volunteers or anyone with limited experience of livestock. The course covers animal health and welfare, the key legislation, the role and responsibilities of a stock checker and how to safely and effectively check livestock. There is a minimum age requirement of 18 years to attend GAP courses.

One Day Livestock Checkers Course: £POA (lunch is included on the day unless otherwise stated). GAP training courses are accredited by Lantra Awards and delegates will receive a certificate by post after successful completion of the course. The certification is included in the course cost. All the trainers GAP uses are also accredited by Lantra.
